May 3	Ephesians 3:16-19 1 John 4:7-21	Love – God's love is total.  Q – Describe the deep love a parent must have in order to sacrifice his only child for the sake of others.
May 4	Ephesians 3:20-21 Psalm 100: 1-5	Praise - Doxology is an expression of praise to God. Q - How would you close a "worship" time?
May 7	Ephesians 4:1 Philippians 1:27-30	Chosen – We are chosen to be Christ's representatives on earth.  Q – How does it make you feel being called Christ's very own?  Does this change your thinking, actions, or desires?
May 8	Ephesians 4:2-3	Peace – Unity takes work, we are not perfect people.



	Colossians 3:12-14	Q – How have you learned to appreciate people who are different from you?
May 9	Ephesians 4:4-6 1 Corinthians 12:12-26	Unity – Believers are united under one God.  Q – How are you united with other believers?
May 10	Ephesians 4:7-10 Matthew 4: 1-11	Assurance – Christ rules all – past, present, future. Q – Knowing God has defeated evil, how does this comfort us as sinners?
May 11	Ephesians 4:11-13 Romans 12:3-8	Spiritual Gifts –Together as a body of Christ, we can accomplish the fullness of Christ.  Q – What are your spiritual gifts? How can these help to grow God's church?
May 14	Ephesians 4:14-16 1 Timothy 4:1-16	Truth – As we mature as believers, we follow Christ and His teachings with our words and actions.  Q – Why is speaking the truth in love necessary if the church is going to do Christ's work in the world?
May 15	Ephesians 4:17-19 Proverbs 3:1-35	Christian Living — Christian life is a process.  Q- How do you stay on track following Christ-like living?
May 16	Ephesians 4:20-24 Romans 6:6-14	Change – Our old way of life, before Christ, is in the past. Q – As you look over your past, what current changes have you made in order to follow Christ?

May 17	Ephesians 4: 25-28 Galatians 6:1-10	Christ-Like – Jesus Christ is our example. Q – Is there someone you know needing help? What can you do that shows Christ-like support?
May 18	Ephesians 4: 29-32 Matthew 12:30-37	Holy Spirit – All believers have the Holy Spirit within themselves. Q – What kind of words come from your mouth?
May 21	Ephesians 5:1-5 1 Thessalonians 1:2- 10	Imitators of God – God's gracious presence.  Q - In what situations is it easy/hard to imitate God?
May 22	Ephesians 5:6-14 John 3:16-21	Christ is the Light – Our "light" should reflect our faith in Jesus. Q – In what areas of your life do you need to change to let Christ's light shine?
May 23	Ephesians 5:15-20 Romans 8:1-17	Godly Wisdom – Understanding God's will and acting obediently.  Q – Is wisdom reserved for the elderly only? Explain.
May 24	Ephesians 5:21-24 1 Peter 3:1-6	Submission – Voluntary yielding to another. Q – Is God's call for submission a positive or negative? Explain.
May 25	Ephesians 5:25-33 1 Peter 3:7	Respect – Christ is the head of the church, Christ loved the church. Q – How do you show respect in your Christian relationships?
May 28	Ephesians 6:1-4 Proverbs 22:6 Deuteronomy 4:9-10 Psalm32:8	Instruction – Guides for Christ-like living.  Q – As a child of God, how do we learn more about Him?



May 29	Ephesians 6:5-9 Hebrews 13:17	Obedience – Summiting to authority.  Q – How are we called to respond to someone in authority over us?
May 30	Ephesians 6:10-15 Deuteronomy 31: 6	Be Strong – Christ is our defense. Q – What defenses are we given in our ongoing struggle with the forces of evil?
May 31	Ephesians 6:16-18 2 Corinthians 10:1-6 1 Corinthians 16:13 Romans 13:11-14	Be Alert – Watch your life and doctrine closely.  Q- In what specific ways or areas does Satan tempt you? Why those ways?
June 1	Ephesians 6:19-24 Matthew 6:5-15	Prayer – An open and continual conversation with God.  *Thank God for His word that we can study, His workers that spread The Word, and His everlasting love for all, His children. Ask for His continued support in our lives as we strive to become more like Him.
