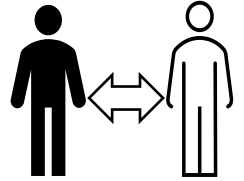




# COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

As we gather for worship, especially showing consideration and love for other worshipers, we have established the following 7 guidelines as minimum protocols to be implemented by the Dwelling. These are consistent with the CDC Guidelines and the Governor's Office Recommendations concerning best practices for houses of worship.

**1. Social Distancing:** *In seating and moving within the building you are encouraged to maintain at least 6' between individuals unless they reside together.*



**2. Hand Sanitizer:** *You are encouraged to use the hand sanitizer stations which are available throughout the building.*

**3. Masks:** *Participants are encouraged to wear a mask, either your own or one provided by the church.*



**4. Sanitation:** *Seating will be disinfected prior to the worship service and other common touch surfaces will be wiped as required throughout the gathering times.*

**5. On-line worship:** *At-risk individuals and anyone demonstrating symptoms are strongly encouraged not to attend in person but to worship with us on-line. We will continue to live stream our service so that we can all worship together even if we are unable or uncomfortable to gather physically.*



**6. Hand Contact:** *Prepackaged refreshments are being offered. We request that you only touch those items you intend to eat and use hand sanitizer. Offering will be taken via a touchless drop station or you may give online.*

**7. Little Dwellers:** *Little Dwellers program is offered on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of each month. If preferred children are welcome to remain with their families throughout the service with elements of the service focused on them.*
